The Christian wedding is fundamentally different from a secular wedding in its basic presuppositions of faith, hope, and love in Jesus Christ. Presbyterians consider the wedding ceremony a service of worship. Reverence shall be expected on the part of all present, and the service shall be under the sole direction of the pastor.

This brochure is intended to answer certain questions for those planning a marriage service at First Presbyterian Church of Las Vegas. It is not intended as a substitute for premarital counseling with one of the pastors. The pastor will decide the direction and number of counseling sessions needed. Premarital counseling is designed to help the couple see their marriage in light of the spiritual, physical, social and economic and intellectual adjustments which marriage requires. Premarital counseling is expected.

All weddings conducted at the First Presbyterian Church of Las Vegas must conform to the policies and theology of the First Presbyterian Church of Las Vegas and the Presbyterian Church (USA). The Session has delegated the supervision of the wedding procedures to the pastor in charge.

MAKING ARRANGEMENTS

Before making plans to be married at First Presbyterian Church you must first consult the church office regarding the availability of dates for the wedding service and rehearsal.



Weddings are not scheduled on Sundays or during Holy Week.

The necessary forms must be completed and returned to the church Wedding Facilitator. At that time the costs related to the wedding will be discussed and a deposit will need to be made to secure the wedding date.

To be eligible for the member rate, either the bride, groom, or one of their parents must be a member of First Presbyterian Church of Las Vegas.

A schedule of fees will be included in the packet along with the forms needed to arrange the ceremony.

Either the Lied Sanctuary or the Hanne Chapel is available for weddings. The chapel seats approximately 120 and the sanctuary seats approximately 600. The Social Hall and the Fireside Room are available for receptions. Various fees and restrictions apply. (See Wedding Packet)

The following **ARE NOT** permitted:

- Alcoholic beverages
- Smoking
- Throwing rice, birdseed or confetti
